

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (REFERENDUMS) (PETITIONS) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2011

Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities (Referendums) (Petitions) (England) Regulations 2011 requires the Council to publish the total number of electors required to sign a petition requiring the council to hold a referendum on whether the local authority should start to operate a mayor and cabinet executive or the committee system.

On 19th February 2016 Satish Mistry, as Proper Officer for and on behalf of Guildford Borough Council, published the number of local government electors within the Borough of Guildford, equal to 5% as shown in the Register of Electors as of 15th February 2016. That number is 5184 (Five Thousand, one hundred and eighty four).

The above published number shall have effect for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions from the date of this notice until 31 March 2017. If the new number published in February 2017 is less than 5184, then the new number will apply from the date it is published.
