

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Guildford Borough Council (Effingham and East Horsley) (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2020

*Made 20 February 2020
Coming into force in accordance with article 1*

Guildford Borough Council (“the council”), in accordance with sections 86 and 88 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 3 December 2019

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 88 and 240 (10) of the 2007 Act

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as The Guildford Borough Council (Effingham and East Horsley) (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2020
- (2) Article 3 of this Order shall come into force on 01 April 2023
- (3) Article 4 of this Order shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2023, and for the purposes of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parish of East Horsley this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made

Interpretation

2. In this Order—
“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983

Alteration of parish area

3. The area hatched and designated by the letter “A” on the map shall cease to be part of the North Ward of the parish of Effingham and shall become part of the parish of East Horsley.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of East Horsley

4. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of East Horsley shall be twelve (12)

Order date

5. 01 April 2023 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008

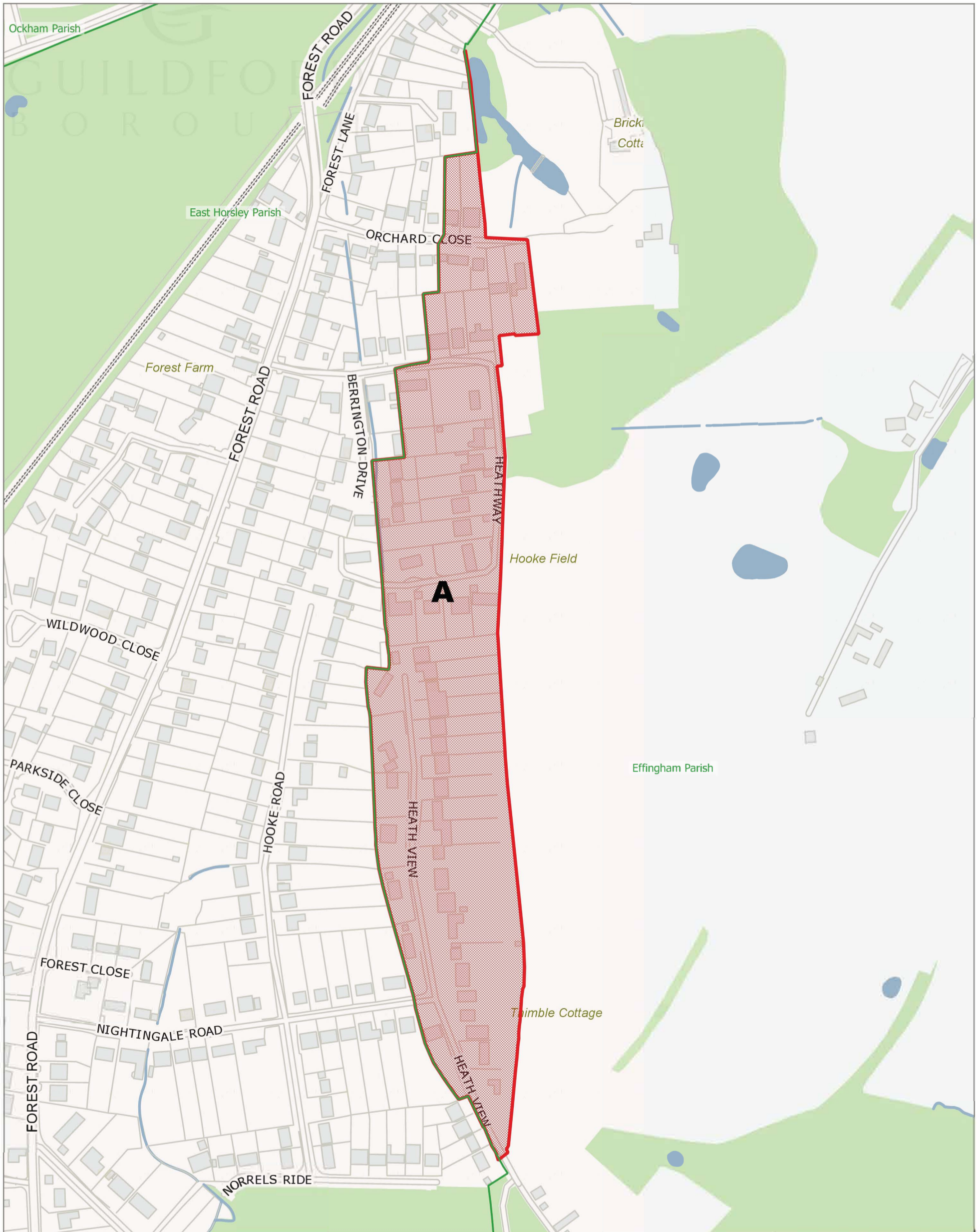
