Take a photo of the completed form and from your MyGuildford account, go into the Account Summary screen where you will see a list of Quick Links on the right-hand side. You need to select the '**Upload information or tell us about something else**' link, attach your photo and in the text box enter 'new direct debit' and send.

Once we have processed your request we will send you a new bill confirming your future payments will be by Direct Debit.

This guarantee should be detached and retained by the payer.

The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Guildford Borough Council will notify you ten working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Guildford Borough Council to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Guildford Borough Council or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Guildford Borough Council asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
